










- ► French explorer Jacques Cartier claims territories in 1534explores the Saint Lawrence river and the French establish fur trading posts

After the declaration of independence the 4th of July 1776 France was the first country to recognize the USA.






Marquis de Lafayette

French frigate Hermione She became famous when she ferried General Lafayette to the United States in 1780 for support to the Americans in the American Revolutionary War








Eiffel Tower 1889
